GUIDANCE NOTES FOR DUOLOGUE APPLICANTS

SECTION ONE - ASSESSMENT DETAILS

Assessment Level

State the level of assessment applied for, either BRONZE, SILVER, GOLD or PLATINUM.

Entry to each level of assessment is by progression, so, for example, you must have passed Bronze to take Silver. State the level, date & venue of your previous highest level Award e.g. SILVER, 13/11/14 RADA

Assessment Date

Assessment dates are on a Saturday at RADA. For up-coming dates, please refer to the website.

State your first choice of assessment date. Due to the popularity of the awards, it is recommended that you also state a second choice.

SECTION TWO - PERSONAL DETAILS

For Duologue applications state both names exactly as you wish them to appear on your Award.

Give the address of just one applicant who will then receive all correspondence regarding the assessment.

State the age each applicant will be on the assessment date. State the gender of each Duologue applicant.

Any change of address must be notified immediately to the Awards Manager in writing.
