SECTION ONE - ASSESSMENT DETAILS

Assessment Level

State the level of assessment applied for, either MESSENGER, BRONZE, SILVER, GOLD or PLATINUM. Entry to each level of assessment is by progression, so, for example, you must have passed Bronze to take Silver.

State the level, date & venue of your previous highest level Award e.g. SILVER, 13/11/14 RADA

Assessment Date

Assessment dates are on a Saturday at RADA. For up-coming dates, please refer to the website. State your first choice of assessment date .

Due to the popularity of the awards, it is recommended that you also state a second choice.
